Duluth Area USBC Association HALL OF FAME QUALIFICATIONS

The purpose of the Hall of Fame shall be to recognize and perpetuate the names of those people who have achieved outstanding performance and/or who have contributed through meritorious service to the game of American Tenpins in the Duluth Area USBC Association

Individuals may be inducted in one of the following categories:

**SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE
MERITORIOUS SERVICE
MEMORIAL HONOR ROLL**

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR ALL APPLICANTS

1. Nominee shall have been a member of the:
 - a. Women – Duluth WBA and/or USBC for at least 15 years.
 - b. Men – Duluth Area BA and/or USBC for at least 15 years.
2. There shall be no stipulation as to age.

SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE QUALIFICATIONS

This award shall be given to a present or past member of Duluth Area BA, Duluth WBA, USBC for outstanding bowling performance.

1. Nominee must have a minimum average of 185 (women), 200 (men) for at least 5 years.
2. Nominee must have participated in 10 or more Duluth Area Local Tournaments - not necessarily consecutive.
3. Nominee shall have won recognition for his/her ability in bowling and must have at least one of the following in sanctioned/certified competition:
 - a. A Duluth Area Local Champion in Team, Doubles, Singles, All Events.
 - b. Other tournament titles/accomplishments.
 - c. Other exceptional bowling accomplishments.

MERITORIOUS SERVICE QUALIFICATIONS

This award shall be given to a present or past Duluth Area BA, Duluth WBA, or USBC member for meritorious service in the Duluth Area USBC.

1. Nominee shall have made outstanding contributions to the good and welfare of the game of tenpins through administrative or organizational work, or through service to Duluth Area Local Association league bowlers.
2. Nominee must have at least 2 of the following:
 - a. Served as an Officer, Director, or Association Manager of a Duluth Local Association.
 - b. Served as a President or Secretary of a Duluth Local Association League for at least 10 years.
 - c. Served as a Chairperson of a committee of a Duluth Local Association.
 - d. Served the Duluth Local Association and contributed valuable service to the game of bowling. Examples: Coaching; activities to promote youth/adult bowling - organizing bowling leagues; organizing bus trips to bowling tournaments, etc.

MEMORIAL HONOR ROLL

This award shall be given posthumously to a former Duluth Area BA, WBA, or USBC member for either their **Superior Performance** and/or **Meritorious Service**.
